



Official Contest Rules

1. This Digital Art contest is open to **COLLEGE STUDENTS** who are at least 18 years of age at the time of entry. **Entries must be submitted by the data owner.** Entrant must have permission to use any images of individuals in the artwork. Individuals may submit only one entry (“Digital Art Piece”) and **attest that they are the owner of accompanying image and hold all rights therein.**
2. Contestants will select one of four categories; **Digital Landscape, Digital Still Life, Digital Portrait, or Digital Experimental,** into which they will submit their single entry.
3. Acceptable file formats: .tif, .eps, .psd, .jpg, pdf. (resolution must be at least 300dpi at 5cm x 5cm).
4. Color or black and white are acceptable; color separation should be CMYK.
5. **A completed Contest Entry Form must accompany each entry.** Entry form and digital file must be cross-referenced. Entries that are incomplete or submitted in a manner contrary with the instructions may be disqualified.
6. By submitting an entry, **owners must agree that the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival and/or City of Thousand Oaks and/or Eastwind Screenprint can use their Digital Art Piece image in any publication** including the Internet, use on T-shirts and/or posters, at the Festival or City’s discretion.
7. **Submission of a Digital Art Piece shall constitute the grant of a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival and City of Thousand Oaks and Eastwind Screenprint to utilize for any purpose,**

including but not limited to publication on the Internet and/or use for marketing publications or promotional items such as T-shirts and posters, etc.

8. Deadline: Entries must be postmarked no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, August 25, 2010.

9. **Winners:** Winners will be notified prior to publication of their image. Winners will be notified by U.S. mail, e-mail or by phone.

10. **Additional Terms and Conditions:** **Contest entrants agree to abide by the terms of these rules and by the decisions of the judges. No responsibility is assumed by the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival or City of Thousand Oaks for lost, late, illegible or damaged entries. All entries become the property of the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival and City of Thousand Oaks and Eastwind Screenprints and will not be returned to entrant. *By entering the contest, entrants agree to have their digital artwork displayed by the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival and City of Thousand Oaks without any fee or other form of compensation other than stated above. By participating in this contest, you agree to release and hold harmless the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival, its sponsors, and City of Thousand Oaks or its employees from all damages or losses of any kind resulting from your participation in this contest.***

Except for title and possession, pursuant to the Copyright Act of 1976 (17 U.S.C. §101 et seq.), Contestant will retain any copyright and all other rights in and to the Digital Art Piece. The Contestant grants to Thousand Oaks Art Festival, City of Thousand Oaks an irrevocable and non-exclusive worldwide license to reproduce, to distribute, and/or to display two- or three-dimensional reproductions of the Digital Art Piece in any manner whatsoever relating to any Thousand Oaks Art Festival, City of Thousand Oaks publication or event, including, without limitation:

- i. Public display as well as reproduction on Thousand Oaks Art Festival, City of Thousand Oaks items, such as print ads, postcards, posters, buttons, applications, and web site;
- ii. Educational, public relations, and/or art promotion purposes;
- iii. Publication of Digital Art Piece in Thousand Oaks Art Festival-produced or City of Thousand Oaks-produced brochures and pamphlets;
- iv. Reproduction in exhibition catalogues, books, slides, postcards, posters, and calendars;
- v. Publication in art magazines, art books, and newspapers;
- vi. Publication in books and magazines not primarily devoted to art but of an educational, historical, or critical nature; and,
- vii. Television programs for educational and/or informational purposes.

Thousand Oaks Art Festival and City of Thousand Oaks will include Contestant's name and the copyright symbol, if any, will appear on or near the image on all printed materials;

Thousand Oaks Art Festival and/or City of Thousand Oaks and Eastwind Screenprints may alter images of the Digital Art Piece as necessary, to fit into reduced or enlarged format sizes.

Thousand Oaks Art Festival and City of Thousand Oaks may use the Digital Art Piece on Thousand Oaks Art Festival or City of Thousand Oaks merchandise and commercial items which may be sold for fundraising purposes.

Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 106A(3) and only to the extent that this Agreement differs, Contestant expressly waives any rights that the he/she may have under Cal. Civ. Code § 987 or 17 U.S.C. §§ 101 et seq., including, without limitation, 17 U.S.C. §§ 106, 106A, and 113, or any successor statute(s) or regulation(s).

11. **Contest winner** will be invited to display artwork at the Thousand Oaks Arts Festival, September 11 & 12 at the Thousand Oaks Civic Arts Plaza and receive an invitation for 2 to the Arts Festival Reception on Friday, Sept. 10, place TBD. Winner will also receive an award certificate on Sunday, Sept. 12, at the Festival on the main stage. Along with a certificate, winner will also receive a grand prize still to be determined.

Thousand Oaks Civic Arts Plaza and The Lakes and Thousand Oaks provide a beautiful venue for the Festival.

The Arts Festival is a juried art show featuring more than 60 local artists presenting their work to the public for sale.
